IWWF Asian Wakeboard Rules

IWWF Asian Wakesurf Rules

Entry Fee:

600 RMB (USD85.00) to compete in one discipline; 900RMB (USD127.00) two compete in two disciplines (wakeboard and wakesurf)

Entry Deadline:

12th July 2023

*Please note that only the first 40 Open category Athletes who register will receive free hotel accommodation

Practice Fee on Non-Official Practice Days: 800 RMB per hour (from 20th to 26th July 2023)

What is Provided for Athletes:

- Access to a RMB109,000.00 (USD15,440.00)
 Cash Purse per Open Category Discipline
- Complimentary Hotel Accommodation (for the first 40 x Athletes who enter the Open Category of any of the disciplines)
 - For <u>Athletes residing outside China</u>: maximum 5 nights (twin share only with another Athlete; earliest check in Wednesday 26th July 2023 and latest check-out Monday, 31st July 2023)
 - For Athletes residing in China, Hong Kong, Macau and Chinese Taipei: maximum 3 nights (twin share only with another Athlete; earliest check in Thursday 27th July 2023 and check-out Sunday, 30th July 2023)
- 3 x Meals per day on Official Practice & Competition Days
- Airport Transfers (from Shijiazhuang Zhengding International Airport <SJW> to the official hotel
- Venue Transfers
- Official Practice on Thursday, 27th July 2023
- Invitation to Opening & Closing Ceremony

What is Not Provided for Athletes:

 Airfares, Personal Accident Insurance (must apply overseas and to competition), Entry Fee

Insurance

Athletes should take out private travel/accident insurance besides their health insurance. Accident insurance should include all accidents arising during wakeboard and wakesurf competitions and applicable overseas/internationally. Your travel insurer should be able to include this as an extra endorsement if you do not have existing coverage. Athletes will be required to sign a waiver upon registering and provide evidence of personal accident insurance before they are permitted to practice and compete.

ANNEXE 1

Entry Conditions & Administration

All athletes must submit their entries by being registered by their respective

Federations in IWWF's Event Management System (EMS).

a. <u>IWWF's Event Management System (EMS)</u>
IWWF's EMS will be used by the organisers to manage the event. Athletes should request their respective <u>Federations</u> to register them in the EMS accordingly.

Example of an athlete's profile on IWWF's EMS: JAEMJAN Padiwat

b. Registration of Athletes Using EMS Each athlete must register to compete in Wakefest ShiJiaZhuang 2023 using IWWF's EMS no later than 12th July 2023. An entry is considered complete when an athlete has registered for the event in EMS and full entry fee payment has been received. Entry fee payment must be made by cash before official practice if residing outside China and by WeChat if residing in China.

The procedure to register for Wakefest ShiJiaZhuang 2023 in EMS is as follows:

- 1. Athlete has to login to EMS
- 2. Go to **My Competitions** and Click on "**New participation**" button. Select the appropriate competition from the list. Filter as follows:

3. Select your category and click on "Submit Participation" button.
